ITDT provides technical assistance on 4 main issues (1)

- Analysis of synergies between adaptation and mitigation options in key sectors (coastal zones, tourism, infrastructure, agriculture, energy, transport, biodiversity)
- 2. Identification of financial opportunities for adaptation and mitigation actions and support for financial proposals preparation
- 3. Capacity building (methodologies, information systems, data collection, training, public awareness and dissemination activities)



ITDT provides technical assistance on 4 main issues (2)

4. NAMA development

- Screening of opportunities in key sectors (energy, transport, agriculture, etc.)
- Identification of regulatory, institutional and financial country-specific needs
- Identification of national key actors and roles (public, private, civil society)
- Identification of existent and potential barriers and ways to overcome them

Why should developing countries elaborate NAMAs?

- To be able to adopt new technologies and practices that allow:
 - Decoupling growth from emissions
 - Reducing imports of fossil fuels
 - Increasing investment potential for adaptation
 - Increasing economic efficiency
 - Improving overall competitiveness
 - Preempt market barriers to key exports
- NAMAs vs CDM projects: will there be market for CERs after 2012?
