## Prioritized sectors for the study

- According to the preliminary analysis conducted for the study. The sectors which will be prioritized for this study are:
  - Renewable Energies
    - Solar
    - Wind

  - Biogas
    - Swine manure
    - Landfill
  - Biomass
    - Principally agriculture
  - Biofuels

## Prerequisites for country participation

1. The country which would like to participate in the regional study should be affiliated to any of the regional organizations such as OLADE, CARICOM or Petrocaribe or any other regional initiative on renewable energies,
2. The country should have within their national objectives or priorities the increase of renewable energies participation in the energy generation,
3. To have established or in process to establish of the regulatory framework which gives incentives for the renewable energy generation,
4. The country should have signed and ratified its participation to the UNFCCC and to the Kyoto Protocol. It is desirable that the participating country has established its DNA and its CDM approval procedure.



## Prerequisites for country participation

5. Country GHG total emissions from the energy sector for the time period of 1990 to 2000 and GHG emission per capita for 2004.
6. Institutional support framework established for the identification and implementation of mitigation projects in your country (desirable, but not mandatory)
